distributed to low-income and at-risk children

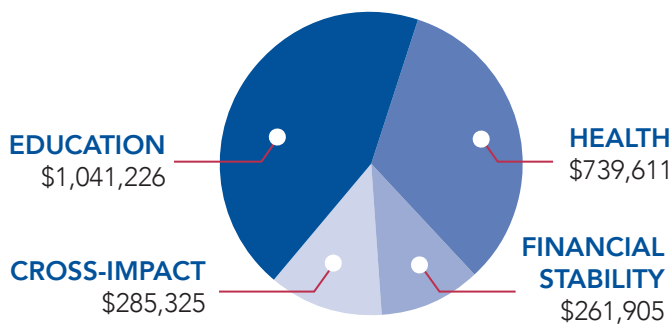
