Youth Opportunity

Programs that **support early childhood development** and **expand access to early learning** through added seats or scholarships.

Programs that **strengthen social-emotional development** and **offer safe, enriching out-of-school opportunities**

Healthy Community

Programs that promote and expand **access to mental and behavioral health supports**.

Programs that provide **medical, dental, or vision care** for underserved individuals.

Programs that increase **access to nutritious, healthy food**.

Financial Stability

Programs that **help individual and families stay housed** through eviction prevention, home repairs, and affordable, attainable housing solutions.

Programs that **address immediate housing needs through crisis shelter**, domestic violence services, and related interventions.

Programs that **strengthen long-term financial stability** through financial literacy and job-skills training.

In addition to our priority areas, extra consideration for programs that

- Co-locate services with other programs to maximize accessibility and convenience
- Offer equitable and flexible hours to accommodate participants' schedules
- Offer services that support the individual and their entire household
- Include ongoing case management to support long-term success
- Utilize data to demonstrate measurable improvements in participants' health or well-being
- Offer supplemental mental, behavioral, or counseling support as secondary services
